YOUTH COURT LISTING BY STATE

Youth courts—also known as teen, peer, and student courts—are programs in which youth sentence their peers for minor delinquent and status offenses and other problem behaviors. Although youth courts have been in existence for more than 30 years, the number of youth courts has increased exponentially over the past decade. According to the National Youth Court Center's database, in 1994 there were only 78 youth court programs in operation; as of March 2006, there were more than 1,100 youth court programs in operation in 49 states, the District of Columbia, and in Puerto Rico. This represents more than a 1,200% increase.

Quick Reference Guide to the National Youth Court Center's Website

The NYCC's website contains myriad information for program coordinators and others interested in the development or enhancement of youth court programs. While information on the website changes daily, the following will provide you with an overview of some of the major features of the website at the time of this publication.

Bookmark and check the homepage often to see "What's New." Announcements about upcoming training events, funding opportunities, and links to newly released publications are among the items to which you can find quick links. There are also quick links that will allow you to subscribe to the free monthly electronic newsletter (NYCC E-Update); join the NYCC mailing list; look at a calendar of events; or find a local youth, teen, peer, or student court near you.

The following is a list of some of the major features of the website that can be accessed by clicking on the appropriate buttons on the left side of the homepage.

Search

If you are having difficulty finding information you need, then you can go here to search the site by keywords.

National Listing of Youth Courts

The NYCC maintains a state-by-state listing of youth, teen, peer, and student courts. Programs are alphabetized by city within each state.

Publications

The majority of publications developed and published by the National Youth Court Center and its allied agencies can be downloaded from this section. Information on how to order hard copies of resources is also provided. A listing of the major publications you can access on this section can be found beginning on page 61.

Resources

This section contains a variety of resources to assist in learning more about youth court and in developing and enhancing youth court programs. Among the resources you can access include:

- ***Frequently Asked Questions:*** Answers common questions about youth courts.
- ***New Coordinator Information:*** This section contains links to answers of questions that are often asked by new program staff of youth court coordinators.
- ***Request for Information Responses:*** Includes a compilation of responses to various email inquiries that youth court coordinators have asked the NYCC to send via the Youth Court Email Group. Some of the questions that have been answered include: Who funds your program? How does your program assess its effectiveness? Does your program provide translation services? What type of educational classes does your program offer? Does your program charge an administrative fee? How does your youth court handle truancy cases? Does your program provide scholarships to volunteers?

- **National Facts and Stats:** Gives an overview of some of the key national facts and statistics including the history of youth court, the number of youth courts in the United States, the types of offenses youth courts accept, the types of dispositions youth court impose, program effectiveness, and types of agencies that administer youth courts.
- **Sample Youth Court Forms:** Provides instructions, samples, and templates for developing forms and resources such as staff and volunteer job descriptions; volunteer applications; code of conducts; client case information sheets; volunteer case schedules; volunteer training agendas; volunteer directories; community service placement and project information sheets; community service and educational class schedules; and respondent, parent, and volunteer satisfaction surveys.
- **Funding Ideas and Grant Writing Tips:** Contains links to websites of interest from government and private sector resources that youth courts may want to investigate for possible funding opportunities, a template for tracking agencies that programs approach for funding (i.e., a Funding Prospect Worksheet), a worksheet for developing a program budget, a compilation of responses to information requests sent to youth courts that ask from where they receive their funding, and notices about current funding opportunities for which youth courts might want to apply. There are also links provided to a variety of websites that provide tips on how to write effective grant proposals.
- **Program Evaluation:** Provides direct links to publications that summarize the results of the national evaluation on teen courts conducted by the Urban Institute, a chart that summarizes other evaluation literature on youth courts, links to download the Participant Manual and PowerPoint slides from the evaluation session of the “Evaluation and Grant Writing Training Seminar” conducted in 2002, and a link to the “Making Evaluation Simpler Using Performance-Based Measures” audio teleconference and webcast.
- **Youth Court Legislation:** Provides a list of states that have enacted enabling legislation for youth courts. There are also links to several articles that have been published summarizing information about youth court legislation.
- **State Youth Court Association and Networking Groups:** Provides contact information and links to state youth court associations and networking groups.
- **Scholarships and Awards:** Lists various scholarship and award opportunities that youth or programs might apply for recognition or money.
- **Resolutions in Support of Youth Court:** Contains information about resolutions passed by various national organizations in support of youth courts.

Online Training

- ***Getting the Most Out of the Deliberation Process:*** Developed by the NYCC to help youth courts train volunteers and respondents who are ordered to serve jury duty on effective deliberation techniques.
- ***Preparing Your Case:*** Developed by the NYCC to serve as a tool for youth attorneys to use in the preparation of their youth court cases. Topics covered include developing opening and closing statements, developing questions to ask during hearings, and interviewing respondents and witnesses.

Developed by Street Law, Inc., the purpose of this lesson is to provide youth court administrators and coordinators with another tool for helping teach the young people in their courts about the effects of underage drinking.  - b) other risks of underage drinking (not related to driving), and
 - c) programs and laws available in their state that attempt to reduce underage drinking.

The Role of Restorative Justice in Teen Courts: A Preliminary Look

In March 2000, the American Probation and Parole Association convened a focus group to examine and discuss the role of restorative justice in teen court programs (also called youth and peer courts). The panel consisted of persons working actively in teen courts and persons working actively in more traditional restorative justice based programs. This paper provides a brief overview of restorative justice principles and addresses several key issues the focus group members identified that serve as a promising foundation from which teen courts can begin to move toward integrating more restorative justice-based practices within their programs. Key issues discussed include how youth courts can rethink the role of victims and the community within their programs, how youth courts can alter the way that their proceedings and practices are structured, and how youth courts can rethink and redefine sentencing options so that they are based on the restorative justice philosophy.

Giving Back: A Community Service-learning Manual for Youth Courts

Impact of Teen Court on Young Offenders

This is the first report of findings from the Evaluation of Teen Courts, which was conducted by the Urban Institute and funded by the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, Office of Justice Programs, U.S. Department of Justice. The Evaluation of Teen Courts Project studied teen courts in four states: Alaska, Arizona, Maryland, and Missouri. Researchers measured pre-court attitudes and post-court recidivism among more than 500 juveniles referred to teen court for nonviolent offenses, such as shoplifting and vandalism. The study compared recidivism outcomes for teen court defendants with outcomes for youth handled by the regular juvenile justice system.

TRAINING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Training Seminars

As of March 2006, the APPA and the NYCC have conducted more than 46 training seminars in over 31 states. These highly interactive training seminars have focused on topics such as developing and establishing youth courts; implementing the national youth court guidelines on a local level; funding and evaluation; and the role of restorative justice in youth courts. More than 1,980 persons have participated in these seminars, representing all fifty states, the Philippines and Canada.

The NYCC continues to offer training seminars for youth court programs on a variety of topics. In 2006, the NYCC will be offering two types of training programs:

- **Implementing and Enhancing Youth Court Programs:** Designed for individuals interested in developing new youth courts and for new youth court program staff.
- **Professional Development Institutes:** Designed for individuals who work in active youth court programs.

CONFERENCES

The National Youth Court Center has conducted two national youth court conferences with support from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. The conferences were held in Albuquerque, NM on October 24-26, 2000 and in Arlington, VA on April 14-16, 2002. Collectively, more than 1,570 youth and adults attended these conferences.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

In addition to the numerous requests for technical assistance that the National Youth Court Center provides via email, telephone contact, and written correspondence, staff or consultants of APPA and NYCC have participated in more than 80 technical assistance events by presenting workshops at conferences and making presentations during or facilitating community meetings. Conferences sponsored by national organizations such as the American Probation and Parole Association, National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges, Academy of Criminal Justice Sciences, and the National Crime Prevention Council. OJJDP and NHTSA are among those which have featured workshops on youth courts. Workshops have also been conducted at various state youth/teen court association conferences.

Agencies that have received onsite technical assistance to assist in developing or enhancing a youth court on a local level include the Orange County Teen Court Program in Orlando, Florida; Lane County Department of Youth Services in Oregon; Deschutes County Department of Community Corrections, Juvenile Division in Oregon; Minnesota Planning, Inc. in St. Paul, Minnesota; 35th Judicial District in Plymouth, Michigan; Police Youth Bureau in Bismarck, North Dakota; Pueblo of Laguna in Laguna, New Mexico, City of Rio Rancho in Loveland, Ohio; and Maricopa County Juvenile Probation

Department in Arizona. Technical assistance has also been provided to the South Dakota Teen Court Association. Beginning in March of 2005, the National Youth Court Center hosts an Annual Meeting for youth court associations and networking groups. The group met in February of 2006, in New Orleans, Louisiana.

Getting the Most Out of the Deliberation Process

The National Youth Court Center has created two Internet-based lessons designed to orient youth volunteers on the deliberation process. Youth watch a video or read a script and then are guided through a series of multiple choice questions that require youth to consider the facts of case, identify victims and consider the impact respondents’ behavior has on victims and the community, and indicate what the respondents’ have already done to make up for their behavior. Youth are then asked to devise a disposition for the respondent.

In order to utilize the online training, youth court directors or coordinators will need to register and be given an access code for their volunteers to use when taking the lesson. This provides a means for the coordinator to view their youths’ test results online in a private access area or via email.

Preparing Your Case

This resource was designed to serve as a tool for youth attorneys to use in the preparation of their youth court cases. Topics covered include developing opening and closing statements, developing questions to ask during hearings, and interviewing respondents and witnesses. Templates are provided for youth volunteers to download and use to prepare for their cases.

Web Search: What do Our Laws and Polices Say About Underage Drinking?

The purpose of this lesson is to provide youth court administrators and coordinators with another tool for helping teach the young people in their courts about the effects of underage drinking. The online lesson guides youth as they conduct research on the Internet about laws relating to:

- a) underage drinking and alcohol-related driving,
- b) other risks of underage drinking (not related to driving), and
- c) programs and laws available in their state that attempt to reduce underage drinking.

Youth Court Database

The National Youth Court Center maintains a comprehensive database that includes detailed information on how youth courts operate in the United States and makes customized searches and requests for information easier to fulfill for staff. The type of information that can be accessed from the database includes the percentage of programs that operate the various youth court program models, the types of offenses that youth court will accept, the types of sentencing options provided by youth courts, the number of persons who volunteer for youth court, and the types of agencies that administer youth court programs.
