## HISTORY

On March 27, 2005, the U.S. Department of Justice began planning the creation of a national association consisting of youth, teen, peer and student courts across America.

In December 2005, an extraordinary and cohesive group of 76 individuals joined to develop the first ever private national association to represent local youth courts, teen courts, student courts and peer courts across America. These individuals, the founding members, served as the 22-member board of trustees and the 54 national committee members. In May 2007, the NAYC was formally established as a nonprofit 501(c)(3).

## OBJECTIVES

- To encourage the development and expansion of youth courts and state associations of youth courts.
- To provide a forum for training of youth and adult volunteers, the sharing of ideas, best practices and resources for the operation of youth courts.
- To provide support for local education, prevention and intervention services to the youth.
- To share information on grants and other funding streams, assisting courts in grant applications.
- To become a pass-through agency for funds received from governmental agencies or private sector grantees.
- To enhance connections and relations with government agencies and community-based programs and organizations.
- To educate public and private agencies, businesses and individuals on the benefits of youth courts.
